SUBJECT: Global Master of Arts Program (GMAP) II Class of 2015 Recruitment

We are now accepting applications for the GMAP II Class of 2015. GMAP II is an intense graduate studies program offered by the Fletcher School at Tufts University that culminates in a Master of Arts degree in International Affairs. This part-time, one-year program combines three two-week residency sessions at the Fletcher School with state-of-the-art internet-based courses of study. The part-time distance learning nature of GMAP II allows students to complete their studies while simultaneously contributing to their organization's mission.

GMAP II is intended for civilian personnel occupying FMS Administrative funded positions within the Security Cooperation arena. Beginning with this application cycle, Security Cooperation personnel serving in O&M billets are eligible to apply. Military personnel seeking DSCA funding may submit their application package and will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis. Applicants must have a bachelor's degree with a recommended GPA of 3.0 or better, a minimum of eight years professional experience, demonstrated leadership potential in international programs, and requisite language skills.

The Fletcher School requires that students demonstrate proficiency in speaking, reading, and writing a foreign language of their choice in order to meet GMAP II graduation requirements. As part of the application, candidates must include Defense Language Proficiency Test scores validating language proficiency.
