SUBJECT: FMS Case Closure Inhibitors (**SAFIAPX 01032**)

There is a requirement for the Air Force to be able to identify the problems associated with the closure of an FMS case and line. A tracking report was created in the CMCS database to identify case closure inhibitors. In order for this report to generate, your financial analysts must input these inhibitors into CMCS. All lines that are in the closure process currently should be added with the appropriate inhibitors, and it is imperative that these inhibitors are updated as the inhibitor condition changes. There is a help menu available when you are creating/updating to assist in the input of inhibitors. Please see attachment 1 for a description of the inhibitors and the menus that will be needed in CMCS to create and update information.

If users find that additional inhibitors would be helpful to further pinpoint closure problems, please forward to SAF/IAPX for inclusion into CMCS.
