SUBJECT: DSAMS Note - AMRAAM Classified Defense Articles (SAF/IAPX - 02041)

Effective immediately, all FMS cases that include AMRAAM missiles and support equipment will include the note "AMRAAM CLASSIFIED DEFENSE ARTICLES". Accordingly, all previous AMRAAM cases will be amended to include this note.

The End-Use Monitoring (EUM) program referred to, as Golden Sentry monitors and reports the use of defense articles and services provided to our foreign customers or international organizations. EUM includes all actions to prevent misuse, including illicit transfer, of these items. The EUM program objective is to minimize the security risks and assure appropriate control procedures inherent in arms transfers is consistent with the need to support US policy objectives. Therefore, including this note in all AMRAAM LOA's will comply with the Golden Sentry End-Use Monitoring Program requirements.

In the same regard please ensure the Anti-Tamper (AT) Measures note IAW DSCA Memoranda, 16 May 2000 (DSCA 00-07) and 4 October 2000 (DSCA 00-16) is also included in all these AMRAAM LOA's.
