SUBJECT: Status Of Forces Agreement (SOFA) Statements For Use In Letter Of Offer And Acceptance (LOA) Documents (**IAPX 03008**) (SAF/IAX Policy Memo, 99026, 18 Nov 99, SAB)

This policy memorandum updates the list of Status Of Forces Agreements (SOFA) Statements (Atch 1).

IAW DoD 5105.38-M, Security Assistance Management Manual (SAMM), Section 70105.F.1 when the USG enters into agreements with countries concerning the legal status of USG personnel carrying out LOA programs, it is desirable that US personnel operate to the extent possible in safety and immunity in US-type conditions. A government-to-government SOFA is commonly used for acquiring safety and immunity for US personnel.

The appropriate statement must be referenced in the LOA, whenever U.S. Government (USG) military or civilian personnel are in country in connection with the LOA.
