SUBJECT: Approval to Write Blanket Order Cartridge Activated Devices/Propellant Actuated Devices (CAD/PAD) Cases (DSCA Memorandum, 00/009591-RT, 10 Aug 2000) (IAX 00017)

Effective immediately, all CAD/PAD cases can be written as blanket order in accordance with referenced memorandum.

This waiver does not alleviate the case or line manager's fiduciary responsibility to ensure a releasability evaluation is accomplished. Further, only USG personnel are authorized to input transactions for the requisitioning of CAD/PAD. Finally, model case CA-D-PAD, version 1 should be used as a template for the creation of all future CAD/PAD cases.
